How to Complete form:-

- SCT** Standard Course Time. The judge will tell you this time before the class begins.
- CAT No.** This is the competitors Number, which has been assigned to them as per the Trial Catalogue. **You will be told by your Lead Steward what number is in the ring. Do not write numbers down in advance, competitors sometimes run out of order.**
- Course Time** This is the time it has taken for the dog to complete the course. **If using Electronic Timing equipment write down the time recorded. If using a manual time clock, the time will be told to you by the timekeeper – you should repeat the time back to the timekeeper for confirmation. (e.g. = 62.01)**
- Time Faults** Time over Standard Course Time (SCT) is recorded in Time Faults, to 1/100th sec. (e.g. Judges SCT = 60. The dog's completed time was 62. 31, Total of Time Faults = 2.31)
If the dog has been Disqualified write DQ in this column.
- Course Faults** **Watch for the Judges signal!**, if the Judge crosses their arms to form an X, this means the dog has been Disqualified – write DQ down in Time Faults column.
 If the Judge holds up a number of fingers, e.g. three, this means the dog has received 3 faults. Different Judges give different signals for Clear Rounds – generally a zero made with two hands, or with one hand.
Clear round = 0 points
Each course fault = 5 points (e.g. 3 course faults = 15 points)
- FOR SCRIBE – ALWAYS REPEAT THE JUDGES SIGNAL BACK TO JUDGE, e.g.: CLEAR ROUND, DQ, 3 FAULTS. THIS CONFIRMS THAT YOU HAVE IT RIGHT.**
- Total Faults** The next 6 columns are for the total faults (points) that the dog has earned.
 If the dog has completed a clear round (zero Faults & below SCT), write 0 in the 0 column.
 If the dog has time faults and/or course faults add them together and enter the total into the appropriate Total Faults column.
 E.g. 3 Time faults + 15 Course fault points = 3+15 =18 (Write 18 in column 16-20)
- Qualify** Put a tick ✓ in this column if the dog has earned 3 zero points i.e:-
0- Time Faults, 0 – Course Faults, 0 – Total Faults (see example for Cat No. 2117).
- Place** Do not fill this. Leave for Trial Secretary or Judge to complete.
 Look for tied scores (*same Course Time and Total Faults*) these may require a run off.
